PLANNING SESSION SUMMARY

Catalyst Architecture, a land planning and development design company, was recently retained by the Tusayan Town Council to start the planning and design process for the Town's twenty acre parcel located at Kotzin Ranch. All residents and interested parties were invited to participate in this planning and design process.

Attendees included **Mayor Greg Bryan and Vice Mayor Craig Sanderson**. Also in attendance were Town Manager Will Wright and Town Clerk Melissa Drake.

Mayor Bryan gave a brief introduction to the affordable housing issues in Tusayan and the Town's first 20-acre housing parcel.

Matthew Ackerman and Barnabus Kane from Catalyst Architecture introduced themselves and gave a brief review of the session which was held on April 11, 2015.

Mr. Ackerman and Mr. Kane facilitated an interactive discussion with the attendees regarding 4 preliminary plat options for the Town's parcel that they have developed since the last session. Each plat contained a different configuration of homes and varied the mix of single family and multifamily homes and townhomes.

Mayor Bryan asked those present to spread the word that the Town is looking for additional public input.
