The following information is publicly disseminated by the Town of Tusayan:

A ballot printing error was caused by the Town of Tusayan on the ballot for the August 30, 2016 Primary Election which affects only the Town Council candidate election.

The Primary Election will proceed, but only to fill the Mayor position because no printing errors affected the election to fill the office of Mayor.

However, no votes in the August 30, 2016 Primary election are to be counted to fill Council seats and notices shall be posted at all polling sites to that effect.

As a result, two four-year (4 year) Council positions will be filled at the November 8, 2016 General Election. Five (5) persons have submitted petitions that qualify them for a four-year Council position to be elected at the November 8, 2016 General Election.

The remainder of the Primary Election ballot consisting of County, State or Federal candidates or initiatives will remain intact and be counted.

The Town of Tusayan apologizes for this error.
