## ORDINANCE NO. 2011-01-19-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF TUSAYAN, ARIZONA RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 2010-09-08-01 ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR THE CREATION OF A MUNICIPAL PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, A.R.S. § 9-461.02 authorizes a city or town to establish a Planning and Zoning Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Tusayan Ordinance No. 2010-09-08-01 ("**Prior Ordinance**") established a procedure for selecting seven persons to serve on the Town of Tusayan Planning and Zoning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Prior Ordinance established no standards for evaluating persons applying to serve on the Planning and Zoning Commission other than Town of Tusayan residency and in some cases permitted the selection of persons to serve on the Planning and Zoning Commission based on a selection by chance; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Tusayan finds that it is important for persons selected to serve on the Town of Tusayan Planning and Zoning Commission have minimum qualifications or experience for such service and also finds that it is important for the Town Council to select such persons based on such qualifications and experience and not based on selection by chance in order that the Planning and Zoning Commission have members with qualifications and experiences that cumulatively permit the Planning and Zoning Commission to serve the best interests of the Town of Tusayan.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Tusayan that Ordinance No. 2010-09-08-01 be hereby rescinded.
