

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-03-21-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TUSAYAN, COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE RECALL ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 13, 2012.

WHEREAS, the Town of Tusayan, Coconino County, Arizona did hold a recall election on the 13th day of March, 2012 for the election of a Mayor and Councilmembers; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to Town Council by the Coconino Elections Department, under contract, and have been canvassed by the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Tusayan, Coconino County, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said recall election, as shown by the poll lists, was 133.

SECTION 2. That the number of ballots to be verified was 133, and that the number voters found to be ineligible were 0.
