

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TUSAYAN, COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 6, 2012

WHEREAS, the Town of Tusayan, Coconino County, Arizona did hold a General Election on the 6th day of November, 2012 for the election of one Councilmember; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the Town Council;

NOW THEREFORE, it is resolved by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Tusayan, Coconino County, Arizona as follows:

SECTION 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said General Election, as shown by the Coconino County Election Summary Report, was 162.


SECTION 2. That the votes cast for the candidates for councilmember were as follows:

Greg Bryan	89	54.94%
Robert Evans, Official Write-in Candidate	64	39.51%
Other Write-in Votes	9	5.56%

SECTION 3. There being 1 council seat left to be filled at the General Election, it is hereby found, determined and declared of record, that the following candidate did receive the highest number of votes and is hereby issued a certificate of election: Greg Bryan.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.


