

**RESOLUTION 2020-11**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TUSAYAN, COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION ON MAY 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020.**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Tusayan, Coconino County, Arizona did hold a Special Election on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of May 2020 to vote on Proposition 432, concerning the approval of a one-year override of the State imposed expenditure limitation for the fiscal year 2020-2021, and;

**WHEREAS**, the election returns have been presented to and canvassed by the Town Council;

**NOW THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TUSAYAN HEREBY RESOLVE THAT:**

**Section 1.** That the total number of votes cast at said Special Election, as shown by the Coconino County Election Summary Report was 94 in the Question of Proposition 432, a one-year override of the State-imposed expenditure limitation for fiscal year 2020-2021.

**Section 2.** That the votes cast at the Special Election were as follows:

To approve Proposition 432 Town of Tusayan:


Yes- 57

No- 37


**Section 3.** As to Proposition 432, the 57 votes comprised a majority of the votes cast; therefore the Town of Tusayan may exceed the state-imposed expenditure limitation for fiscal year 2020-2021 by \$22,900,000 to allow the Town to provide services subject to local control of expenditures by Tusayan Residents.
