**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TUSAYAN,
ARIZONA REGARDING REQUESTS FOR AGENDA ITEMS:**

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, The Town of Tusayan recognizes that the best policy is usually made with time for thoughtful deliberation.

WHEREAS, The Town of Tusayan recognizes that allowing time for proper preparation of supporting materials is an important contributing factor in fostering that environment of thoughtful deliberation.

WHEREAS, The Town of Tusayan recognizes the need for providing proper resources for community participation in the public meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TUSAYAN as follows:

1. Requests to add an item to the agenda of an upcoming special or regular meeting of the Tusayan Town Council will not be granted, except for good cause, if granting such a request would require an amendment to the agenda within 72 hours of the meeting. Weekends and holidays will be excluded from the 72 hour calculation.
2. A request to add an agenda item will be viewed with increased scrutiny where the individual making the request reasonably could or should have foreseen the need to request the item earlier.
