

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TUSAYAN, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE USE OF TOWN HALL FOR CERTAIN EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Town of Tusayan (the "Town") has established a focus area to "promote programs...and events...where all members of the community can come together to participate in opportunities of learning."

WHEREAS, the Town has hosted many exceptional and quality educational opportunities at Town Hall in the past.

WHEREAS, these opportunities have benefitted the community as a whole.


WHEREAS, there are many great community partners who are willing to work with the Town in offering these opportunities to the community, free of charge, if a location is available.

WHEREAS, these community partners include, but are not limited to, other governmental organizations (state, county, and federal), not for profit organizations, evangelical organizations, and schools.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TUSAYAN as follows:

1. The use of Town Hall is set aside for educational purposes on at least a semiannual basis.
2. It is encouraged that such use will be as often as monthly.
3. The Town Manager (and staff) is encouraged to work in conjunction with as many varied community partners as feasible to bring quality educational programming to the Tusayan Community.
4. Such usage should be during normally scheduled business hours, when staff is available to accommodate such requests and when the facilities are not in use for other planned Town Business.
5. Educational purposes that are not in accordance with Town Policy, Resolution, Ordinance or are of a political nature are strictly forbidden.
6. Interpretation of the Town Policy is within the sole discretion of the Town.
