

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2014-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TUSAYAN, COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 4, 2014.

WHEREAS, the Town of Tusayan, Coconino County, Arizona did hold a General Election on the 4th day of November, 2014 for Proposition 407 (Direct Election of the Mayor); and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the Town Council;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Tusayan, Coconino County, Arizona as follows:

SECTION 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said General Election, as shown by the Coconino County Election Summary Report, was **101**.


SECTION 2. That the votes cast for and against Proposition 407 (Direct Election of the Mayor) were as follows:

Yes	67	66.34%
No	34	33.66%

SECTION 3. It is hereby found, determined and declared of record that Proposition 407 (Direct Election of Mayor) has been approved by the majority of the voters.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.

PASSED AND ADOPTED BY the Mayor and Council of the Town of Tusayan, Arizona, this 19th day of November, 2014.




