**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TUSAYAN,  
COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA CALLING FOR A ONE-TIME OVERRIDE  
ELECTION ON MAY 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020.**

**WHEREAS**, the voters approved the Town's proposed extension of an alternate expenditure limitation on November 6, 2018, but the approval was invalidated by the Arizona Auditor General's office in January 2019;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-563.01 and Ariz. Const. art. IX Sec. 20(2)(c), the Town of Tusayan ("Town") is authorized hold an override election to authorize the expenditure of funds in excess of the state expenditure limit; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town has determined that it is necessary to call an election for the purpose of approving a one-time override in the amount of \$22,900,000 and for the purposes specified below.

**NOW THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TUSAYAN HEREBY RESOLVE THAT:**

1. The Town calls for the election for the purpose of approving a one-time override in the amount of \$22,900,000 and for the following purposes: support of the Tusayan Fire Department, educational programs at Grand Canyon Unified School District, the sport complex at the Grand Canyon Unified School District, the Kaibab Learning Center, internet improvement, affordable housing initiative, addressing traffic and public safety concerns, supporting community organizations, drainage projects, floodplain maintenance, and flood mitigation retention basins, Town trailways project, and Town administration and administrative services; and
2. The date set for filing arguments for or against the proposed override is 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 28, 2020. Arguments for or against must be no longer than 200 words and shall be submitted to the Town Clerk; and
3. Town staff is directed to prepare the publicity pamphlet, including the argument in favor of the override election on behalf of the Town, and the ballot as required by law and take any other steps as may be necessary to move forward with conducting an override election as set forth herein.
