

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TUSAYAN, COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON AUGUST 28, 2012.

WHEREAS, the Town of Tusayan, Coconino County, Arizona did hold a Primary Election on the 28th day of August, 2012 for the nomination/election of two Councilmembers; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the Town Council;

NOW THEREFORE, it is resolved by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Tusayan, Coconino County, Arizona as follows:

SECTION 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said Primary Election, as shown by the Coconino County Election Summary Report, was 63.

SECTION 2. That the number of provisional ballots to be verified was 2, and that voters found to be ineligible were 0.

SECTION 3. That the votes cast for the candidates for councilmember were as follows:


Greg Bryan	28	29.47%
Al Montoya	32	33.68%
Write-in Votes	35	36.84%

SECTION 4. That it is hereby found, determined and declared of record that the following candidate did receive more than one-half of the total number of valid votes cast and is hereby issued a certificate of election: Al Montoya

SECTION 5. That it is hereby found, determined, and declared of record that the


following candidate did not receive more than one-half of the total number of valid votes at said election and shall have their name placed on the General Municipal Election ballot of the Town of Tusayan, Coconino County, Arizona, to be held on November 6, 2012, and is hereby issued a certificate of nomination: Greg Bryan


