

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TUSAYAN, COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT \$18,241,933, ADOPTING THE ESTIMATED AMOUNTS REQUIRED TO MEET THE PUBLIC EXPENSES FOR THE TOWN OF TUSAYAN FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING PUBLICATION OF STATEMENTS AND SCHEDULES OF THE TENTATIVE BUDGET, TOGETHER WITH NOTICE OF PUBLIC NOTICE ON SAID AND NOTICE OF FINAL ADOPTION OF SAID BUDGET.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. Sections 42-17101 and 42-17102, cities and towns are required to prepare, on or before the third Monday in July of each year, an annual budget containing estimated expenditures/expenses and projected revenues on forms developed by the Office of the Auditor General; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with A.R.S. Section 42-17103, the governing body shall publish a summary of the estimates of revenues and expenditures/expenses and, to hear taxpayers, a notice of a public hearing once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the Town after the estimates are tentatively adopted, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council held a meeting on June 8, 2022, to review, and make adjustments as deemed warranted, the estimated expenditures/expenses and projected revenues for Town's fiscal year ending June 30, 2023.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE Town Council of the Town of Tusayan:

1. The estimates of revenues and expenditures/expenses shown on the accompany schedules are hereby adopted as the tentative budget of the Town of Tusayan for the Fiscal Year 2022-2023; and
2. a public hearing on the budget shall be held at 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 13, 2022; and
3. the budget in the state required format and a notice of the hearing shall be publish as required by law.
