A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TUSAYAN ARIZONA REGARDING THE 2034 GENERAL PLAN REWRITE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PLAN

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, The Town of Tusayan has embarked on a rewrite of its General Plan.

WHEREAS, Public Participation is an essential component of developing the General Plan.

WHEREAS, Public Participation through a variety of means and opportunities is generally the best means of garnering public input

ENACTMENTS:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Town of Tusayan Mayor and Council as follows:

Town Staff is hereby authorized to implement the following plan with regards to public participation:

Information will be provided through and feedback will be gathered through the following channels/outlets

- 1) **Town Website** – Link to 2034 General Plan information, posting the of plan draft(s), etc.
- 2) **Town's Facebook Page** – Posting of occasional updates for the 2034 General Plan
- 3) **Stakeholder Outreach** – This includes talking with community leaders, including people that direct a variety of private, public, and government organizations. Interviews include finding out what needs, goals, and projects each organization has on their agenda in the short-, medium- and long-term and how these may influence the Town's planning needs.
- 4) **Council Meeting Dates** –Technical review of the General Plan draft will occur through the Council Regular Meeting Dates, on the Second Tuesday of the Month. These meetings will also serve as an open house-like opportunity for the public to comment. This will effectively provide a monthly citizen input opportunity.
- 5) **60-Day Agency Review** – Once a baseline draft of the new plan is ready for distribution, it will be transmitted to approximately a dozen partner agencies such as the Forest Service, NACOG, AZ State Land Department, and so on. As required by State statute, the Town will provide these agencies with at least 60 calendar days of review prior to a Planning and Zoning Commission formal citizen review meeting.
- 6) **Williams-Grand Canyon News / Grand Canyon News** – Required Public Notice will be printed in WGCN
- 7) **Public Posting of Hearings outside of Town Hall** – As required by State law, notices of the General Plan public hearings will be publicly posted, including outside of Town Hall.

8) **Public Hearings** – As the General Plan process wraps up, the Planning and Zoning Commission will hold a public hearing and make a recommendation on the 2034 General Plan to the Town Council. The Town Council will then consider the PZ recommendation and consider adoption of the plan by Resolution. Opportunities for final public input will be available at each hearing.
